- 1 cup of milk

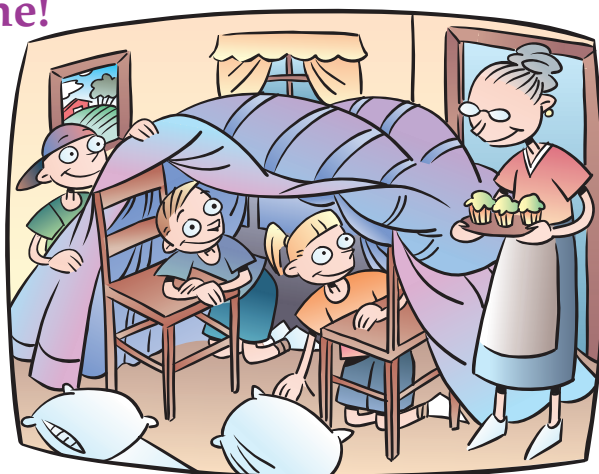
Stir in the vanilla and sugar (to taste.) Gradually stir milk (to the desired consistency.)

Outdoor fun:

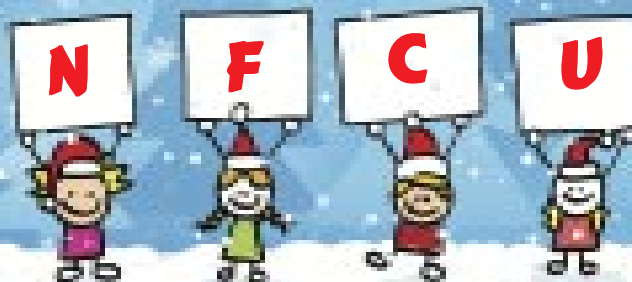
